Open Water Course

Course Structure:

DAY 1: Practical work in the pool as well as Theory revision, exam and other administration.

Day 2 & 3: A series of five open water dives.



About the Course:

1. The Open Water Course is designed to train divers to plan and conduct their own dives at depths down to 18m in conditions similar to that in which you are trained. The Open Water Course is the starting point for further diving qualifications. Students that successfully pass the exam and practical phase of the course are issued with a Certification Card which can be used all over the world as proof of their diving qualifications and experience.
2. The duration of the course is 3 days (four days if you want to do the theory in the classroom face-to-face with your instructor: extra charge applies).
3. You will be required to complete a dive medical questionnaire. Some people may be required to undergo an Australian Standard dive medical examination and have been certified 'Fit to Dive' before the beginning of the course. Please contact us for details and forms etc.
4. You need to be comfortable in the water and have basic swimming skills. You don't need to be an athlete, but you should be generally in good health. Mentally, you need a mature attitude and the self-discipline to follow the guide-lines and principles required for safe diving.
5. The minimum age for scuba certification is 10 for the Junior Open Water (adult supervised diving), and 15 for the Open Water Diver certification.
6. This certification shows that you successfully completed the course having met the training standards & requirements. Dive centres and resorts require a person to be a certified diver or in training before they will rent or sell you scuba equipment, fill scuba tanks for you, or let you participate in scuba activities.
